Articles of African Imperial Empire Kingdom Decree - 10. 02. 2006

Her Imperial Majesty The Imperial Empress Shebah `RA has Decreed the Imperial Kingdoms Imperial Central Government be completely re-structure to facilitate better and correct Governance of all the Kingdom and Governments of the African Kingdoms Nations of the Imperial Empire Kingdom.

To facilitate such (HIM) Her Imperial Majesty The Imperial Empress has Decreed the Inauguration of the Her Imperial Majesty's African Imperial Empire; Imperial Central Government of the Imperial Kingdom covering the Imperial Kingdoms Empire of Kingdom Nations and Governments with immediate effect.

HIM Imperial Decreed Imperial Central Government Formation:-

Article 1-1

The Imperial Central Government and Cabinets Working Capital for the within this document set Decrees and Programs shall be generated from the as per Imperial Decree designated Kingdoms Assets as described within this document.

- (a) The Imperial Kingdom Office of the Imperial House Central Government shall retain its title name:-
- The Imperial Office - of The Imperial Kingdom Central Government.
- (b) The nominated Kingdom Region for the construction of the Imperial Central Government Ministries and Imperial Office shall be later disclosed. The present Federation offices shall remain until that time.

As Imperial Head of the Empire Kingdoms and its Governments, The Imperial Head of The Imperial Kingdom has the final Veto on any and all matters of the Imperial Kingdom Empire, Central Government, and all Imperial Kingdoms Royal Offices & Official Organs internally and internationally on matters of Empire and Central Government, Empire interest, Empire Projects, Empire Continental Territory and Empire Treasury in its entirety.

Article 1-4

(a) 2nd - Highest Office of Command of Imperial Government - Imperial Kingdom Secretariat:-

The Imperial Office Secretariat of The Imperial Prince/King of The Imperial Empire & HIM Central Government.

- HIM Head Imperial House Affairs-HIM Second in Command - Internal and International Affairs and Security Head which is the Imperial House Office above the Head of Government and directly under the Imperial Office of the Imperial Monarch. It is the Office of HIM co-Regent - The Imperial King of The Empire. The Imperial Secretariat holds the Crown Office of Imperial Kings of Kings - The Imperial Crown Secretariat of the Imperial Kings of The Empire. The Sons of The Lines of The Matriarchs. The Imperial Secretariat of The Imperial Kings at the Imperial Office Imperial responsible is to enforce the Decrees, Rulings and Laws of the Empire Throne throughout the Empire the Empires Central Government.

Article 1-5

(b) The Imperial Kingdom Secretariat:-

The Imperial Secretariat is the Secretariat of HIM second-in-Command of Central Government HIH The Imperial Prince of The Imperial Kingdom Empire holds the Imperial House office for all Internal and International Affaires & Imperial Kingdoms Security. The Imperial Prince Secretariat holds authority over the Imperial Kingdoms Head of Central Government and the Central Government Ministries.

 - All proposal of the HIM Central government as per the Kingdoms internal protocol is addressed to HIM Imperial Office. The Imperial Head approves or denies the request of the Central Governments. When a request is approved by Imperial Utterance of The Imperial Head as a Imperial Decreed or Imperial Command/Order/Instruction.
- (d)
 - The Proclamation of the Decree and its enforcement is the responsibility of The Imperial Secretariat of the Imperial Prince to Imperial Order/Law by Imperial Office Command of The Imperial Head of The Kingdoms to the

- The Head of Central Government instructs the Prime Minister on its implementation. The implementation of the Imperial Decree is the responsibility of The Prime Minister of The Central Government and His Ministers of Central Governmental and respective Ministries for the immediate start of its required implementation until its realisation in accordance to the Imperial Decree.

- The Head of Central Governments and The Prime Minister of Central Government are responsible to The Imperial Secretariat for all matters of the correct and complete implementation of the Imperial Order.

Imperial House - Central Government / Government and Cabinets Selection & Formation:-

(a) The Imperial House Central Government Ministers comprises of Africans of internal and external experience of Kingdoms and National Government from within the Empire Kingdom Nations and from within the Kingdoms Nations people of National Government, to that of the Imperial Central Government Ministries of The Imperial Matriarchal Kingdom of the Empire Kingdom of Africa the African Continent.

(b) Imperial House Head of Government Official Posting:-

- Imperial House Head of Government and Sovereign Cabinet Chambers are formed from the Imperial Chambers of African Sovereigns and African Royal Kingdoms Federation Sovereigns and posted by Imperial Kingdom Decree by the of the Imperial Head of Kingdoms.
- HIM Prime Minister of the Central Government and respective Imperial Government Ministers are formed from within the Kingdom Nations Internal Ministries and Members of Trans-African Governmental Community by Decree of the Imperial Head of Kingdoms.

Article 1-13

HIM Prime Minister of Central Government Formal Placement:-

(a) Her Imperial Majesty's Prime Minister and Ministries are under the responsibility of the Head of Central Government and Sovereign Cabinets. The Prime Ministers Office and Ministries are responsible for the implementation of the decrees of the Imperial House Imperial Office to HIM Head of Central Cabinet for the Central Government Ministries.

- (b) The Prime Ministers respective Ministries are supported by HIM Advisory Cabinet to realise the set Decrees, Instructions, Ventures or Agreements towards internal development and Expansion.
- (c) All present internal Kingdoms Cabinet and Government are under HIM Imperial Sovereign Central Cabinet and Central Governments responsibility respectively.

Selection & Appointment of Central Government Ministers:-

- (d) The Ministers of Central Government are called to Office by the Imperial Head of the Imperial Kingdom directly or by Imperial instructions to HIM Head of Government and Sovereign Cabinet.
- (e) HIM Head of Government and the Sovereign Cabinet Chambers select respective and qualified candidates for the Imperial Head approval.
- (f) The candidates for Central Governmental Ministers are selected from throughout the African Kingdoms of exceptional Kingdom or National Governmental Ministerial records of performance, correct qualifications and international exposure and experience within the International Diplomatic Corps for their respective Central Government Official Posting to the Imperial Government of the African Continent of Nations Imperial Throne.

Article 1-16 (C) The Imperial Matriarch Cabinets of Imperial Kings of Kings and Royal Kings.

The Imperial Kingdom and Imperial and Royal Kingdoms Kings/Queens Monarchs of HIM Chambers of Sovereigns & the Trans-African Inter-National Federation of African Kingdoms Sovereigns of the Royal Kingdoms of Africa functioning as one Sovereign Body of Monarchs, forming HIM – HER IMPERIAL MAJESTY Sovereigns Cabinet to their Imperial Sovereign Head HIM. Together forming the HIM Sovereign Chambers of Imperial Cabinet –Sovereign Cabinet-to the Central Government. These Cabinets includes the Internal Imperial Military Cabinet of the Imperial Secretariat. HIM Military Cabinet is responsible for the Protection and Security of the Throne under its Imperial Commander:- The Imperial Matriarchal Head of the Empire.

HIM Internal Private Council and Cabinets:-

(a) Comprises of HIM direct private Internal Heads of Staff of the Imperial Commissariat and Imperial Secretariat of the Imperial Office.

(c) HIM Special Advisory Cabinet of Trans-African & International Advisors of Governments & Icons of the International Economic, Industry & Commerce Global Business Community to the Central Government Imperial Office as HIM Special Advisory Cabinet for the Trans-African Continental Urban/Rural Commercial Development Agenda.

(d) The Advisory Trans-African & International Member Cabinets formal Royal Office is within HIM Imperial Offices.

Article 1-17

**Imperial House Royal Kingdoms Governments Ministerial Offices immediate
Agenda for 2006-2010 shall put in place the following**

(a) Empire Royal Kingdoms Governmental Facilities that shall be realised by the Central Government for the internal respective Kingdoms Ministries throughout the Empire Kingdoms better functioning:-

1. The respective Kingdoms Governments and Ministries within the respective Kingdoms shall be funded to renovate and reconstruct to a higher standard its present offices.
2. They shall as well be funded to expand on qualified Staff.
3. The Kingdom Community shall be furnish with finance through the Kingdoms joint resources to build their Nations infra-structure and internal Commerce to sustain there growth.
4. The Kings and Queens shall instruct their Cabinets to inform the Central Cabinet what tools or advise they respectively need to do so, shall be provided to them.
5. They shall equally inform the Central Government of the areas that needs address for its success and greater empowerment of the respective Monarchs for the better care of their Kingdoms for its stability and growth.
6. The needed tools of Communications established within the Kingdoms for effective government.
7. The needed tools for Social care for the people so they can be put to work towards the rebuilding of there future in accordance to their own possibilities to participate in that rebuilding, the stronger shall carry the less strong in doing that. This can be in the form of multi-function and re-locatable temporary housing, Medical care Temporary Offices, Commercial Centres, Farm Supplies
8. To this end the Imperial House Foundation – USA and the European France Head –Office and International Secretariats are the key to the realisation of accomplishing that with a supply of good qualified and well tooled Multi-nationals and Business Corporations from around the world to work with our Advisory Cabinet and Commercial Ministry to accomplish that goal.
9. The Imperial House –Africa shall focus on the channelling of resources into funds for continuous payment of the services necessary to realise the physical reconstruction but they shall work with us and hear the voice of the Nation in doing that.

10. Advisory Cabinet of National and International Ministers advising and guiding the Sovereign Cabinets and directly the respective Kingdoms Cabinets Chiefs to achieve the set goals.
11. The Imperial Office shall function as an advisory Board to the Imperial House Foundation Africa Central Sovereign Head-Quarters as to what Kingdoms regions shall be addressed for specific and critical rebuilding whilst we set the right structure and people in place as to get this start and its long-term structure.
12. This shall be presented by each Kingdom to the Sovereign Central Cabinet for the Central Government to address.
13. The Prime Minister and his Ministries of Him Central Government Ministries is responsible to carry out the rulings of decree of the Imperial Head to HIM Cabinet.
14. The Imperial House Internal and International Affairs and Security Head is independent of them, that office is there to Monitor and guide the proper working and unity of the Central Government in its totality, for the Imperial Throne.
15. The three Offices that Form the Central Government to affect its office correctly shall stand above the other two. It is the working Office of the Imperial House and as such the Imperial Throne. It is the Office of the Imperial Head of the Empire of African Kingdoms and HIM Imperial House Head of Internal and International Affairs and Security.

Article 1-18

The Advisory Cabinet Members of The Trans-Africa Heads of States of The ECOWAS, the African Union and CARICOM Heads of States Members of the Advisory Cabinet to the Imperial Office:-

There appointed Purpose:-

- (a) The Realisation Implementation of the Trans-African & CARICOM Internal National Development Agenda within their respective Nations through the full financial support of Imperial Office & HIM Central Government, towards global development and eradication of Poverty in their respective Nations. The Internal Development facilitation within their respective Nations Internal Development Agenda towards Progress, an Open Market with the Trans-African Nations, stronger ties an a growing stable Economy of the Global Community towards Nation building, Social-Economical Progress, strengthen Inter-Governmental co-operation and ties towards Global Peace.
- (b) The Physical Realisation of the CARICOM 2020 Nations internal development 2020 Agenda simultaneously with the Imperial Kingdom Trans-African Development Agenda with The Imperial Office and HIM Central Government.

Towards the future opening of the Markets between Africa, The American Continent, The United Kingdom & Countries & Islands of The Americas with stronger and closer ties, for Peace, stronger economical infra-structure by an assured Inter-National Community Market towards Economical Stability, a Future for ALL the Nations, Progress and the road to Peace.

- (c) The Trans-African & CARICOM Members formal Office is within the Imperial Office of HIM Central Government. The CARICOM Members second-Office is The Imperial Secretariat for The CARICOM in The Republic of Trinidad & Tobago for the CARICOM Members of The Americas.
- (d) The Members of HIM Cabinet including that of HIM Private Internal Cabinet are appointed by Imperial Decree of HIM.

Article 1-19

HIM Trans-African Heads of State of National Governments Advisory Councils to:-

- (a) The Imperial House Trans-African Heads of State of National Governments Advisory Council is the joint working and Advisory Councils for African Heads of State of Government and the Imperial House Central Government on African Internal Development matters and Trans-African Security and Peace.
- (b) The Trans-African Heads of State of National Government Advisory Council has the authorisation and authority from the Central Government for the supporting working of the Central Governments Security & Peace Corps with the African Union Peace Corps.
- (c) The Trans-African & CARICOM Members Heads of State of National Government Advisory Council to HIM is advised and supported by HIM Special Advisory Cabinet on matters of the respective development realisation and infra-structural design and development with the relevant and respective Ministries of National Government and Central Government Ministries.
- (d) The respective member of HIM Trans-African & CARICOM Members Heads of States of National Government Advisory Council to the Imperial Kingdom has a permanent representative on the Board of the Council responsible for the Development portfolio of the respective represented National Government.
- (e) The National Development Project of the portfolio of the Head of State of National Government of the respective country Head of State Council - Members of HIM Trans-African & CARICOM Members Advisory Council of Heads of States of National Governments Permanent Secretariats & Missions to the Imperial House are Finance through the Imperial Office and the Respective National Government.

- (h) The Chamber of Commerce shall structure and Internal Division of Field Inspectors to control that the criterion as per the registration object be in accordance to Imperial House requirements which covers and includes the Trans-African National requirements and that of the International Community accepted standards, in order to Commence Business within the Kingdoms Empire and Internationally.

The registration protocols shall differ in accordance to the to be registered business or service and shall includes, the documents of:-

- (g) National requirements, and International requirements when applicable
- (h) Banking/Insurance and Farmers Support Subsidies
- (i) Business Communications
- (j) Market Customisation
- (k) Rural Communities Co-operations Forming
- (l) Farm Land preservation and rejuvenation
- (m) Problem Solving
- (n) Reading and Writing for Seniors
- (o) Respective requested Course on the Chambers of Commerce and Industry Development Education Portfolio for the Rural Regions.

Article 4-4

- (a) The Chambers of Commerce shall form Regional and Rural Mobile and Standard Offices to address the Community development issues and questions of the Local Community on what they need to support their Community Development, which shall effectively be addressed by the Chambers directly or through the Chambers to the relevant authority to do such.
- (b) As such the Chamber of Commerce shall be taxed with the responsibility of registering and insuring the registered enterprise for a nominated amount upon registration and yearly thereafter, and the simulation of Community Development and upkeep of Global requires building and strengthening Rural Trade.

International Governments Referral Address for Participation:-

- (a)
International inter-Kingdom or International Government referral on matters of Governmental participation on the infra-structural projects agenda shall be to the Imperial House Central Government or Imperial House Foundation - Africa directly for presentation to the Central Government.

Nominated Countries for the opening of Imperial House Foundation International Central Head-Quarters and Secretariats:-

The Imperial House Foundation international Head-Quarters and International Secretariats shall be opened in the here-under named nominated countries:-

- (a) Washington or New York as the Imperial House Foundation- USA Central International Head-Quarters - covering the USA, The American Continent, The Americas, China, Japan, India, Saudi-Arabia, Iraq, The Emirates, Jordan, Israel and countries hereunder not specifically included.
- (b) Paris France- The French Head-office shall be the Head-Office for the European Secretariats covering the Schengen European Countries.
- (c) London, England – The United Kingdoms Head-Office covering the United Kingdom of Great Britain, the Non-Schengen European Countries and the Middle-East.
- (d) Zurich - Switzerland covering Switzerland, the Principality of Liechtenstein and Turkey.
- (e) Madrid Spain – covering Spain and Portugal
- (f) Port-of-Spain Trinidad - covering The Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and the CARICOM Member Countries with exception of Venezuela, this is a specific and an irrevocable order of HIM until further notice, their shall be no participation on the Imperial House Foundation projects from that territory.

- (g) Dubai and United Arab Emirates - to cover the Middle-Eastern Countries.

Article 5-3

Imperial House Foundation – USA, Special authorisation:-

The Imperial House Foundation-USA internal Secretariat shall be formally authorised by Federation with the responsible for final screening of Multi-National and Private Entrepreneurs before presentation to the Imperial House Africa of all sensitive international continental regions. Africa/USA shall be the countries of Jurisdiction for all international matters outside of Africa in matters of legal conflicts or disagreements.

Article 5-6

Sanction, Embargo, and Non-Nominated Countries for Imperial House Reconstruction Agenda Participation, or relationship in any form with the African Kingdoms Federation, Kingdoms and any and all Kingdoms entities, concerns, local or private throughout the Empire:-

There shall be no participation of the any countries outside of Africa by any request or by any form unless by Imperial Decree in cases of the following:-

- (1) Countries, Islands or Nations Internationally formally listed by the African Kingdoms Federation as a possible threat or as directly, indirectly or passively; hosting, supporting, allowing or encouraging any and all:
 - (a) Disrespect to the Empire Sovereignty
 - (b) Disrespect to the Imperial Matriarch
 - (c) Disrespect to the African Kingdoms Empire Imperial Throne
 - (d) Disrespect to the Empire Central Government
 - (e) Disrespect to the African Kingdoms respective Sovereignty
 - (f) Disrespect to the African Kingdom Federation authority
 - (g) Disrespect to the African Kingdoms Monarchs,
 - (h) Disrespect to the African Kingdoms People, Culture, Tradition, Rights and Social Cultures, including within the African Diaspora nations or communities
 - (i) Disrespect through acts of Terrorist activities towards the African People and Humanity in its totality.
 - (j) Disrespect to the African Nations People in there totality
 - (k) Disrespect to the African Kingdoms Ancestors, Heritage and Imperial Laws

Article 5-7

- (2) Any Countries whose policies and politics are aimed intentionally to create;
 - (a) International/Internal unrest to aggravate possible sanctions,
 - (b) or incite to trade war or destabilising the Federation and/or United Nation efforts for Global Political stability,
 - (c) or whose internal Political activities inciting unrest within or towards any Global regions or Government.

- (d) Any listed African Countries falls directly under Imperial Kingdoms and Imperial Central Government internal projects pre-screening before final development activation decisions are established.

Constitution of the African Continent Kingdoms Federation

Article 6

Article 1 - 1.

(1)

The Imperial Sovereign Institution of Sheba Kingdoms Nations Federation Monarchs, together with its Councils as established by Imperial law and usage, is hereby guaranteed.

(2)

With exception of the Kingdoms own Central Government, National Parliaments in accordance with Federation and National Constitutional Laws shall have no power to enact any law which-

(a)

Confers on any person or authority the right to accord or withdraw recognition to or from a King/Queen/Sultan for any purpose whatsoever; or

(b)

Detracts or derogates in any way from the Honour and Dignity of the Institution of Monarchies, Governments and Monarchical Institutions.

(3)

Nothing in or done under the authority of any law shall be held to be inconsistent with, or in contravention of, clause (1) or (2) of this article if the law makes provision for-

(a)

The determination, in accordance with the appropriate Imperial Customary law and usage, by an Imperial Council, a Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans or a Monarchies Committee of any of them, of the validity of the nomination, election, selection, installation or deposition of a person as a King/Queen/Sultan;

(b)

An Imperial Council or a Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans or the Federation Kingdom/Regional/National or Trans-Kingdom/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans to establish and operate a procedure for the registration of Kings/Queens/Sultans and the public notification in the Gazette or otherwise of the status of persons as Kings/Queens/Sultans in Africa.

Article 1 - 2.

(1)

There shall be an Imperial Federation Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans, comprising of the Kingdoms/National and Trans-Kingdom/National Houses of Kings/Queens/Sultans.

(2)

The Imperial House of Kings/Queens/Sultans of each Imperial Kingdom/Region/State shall elect as members of the Federation Trans-National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans five paramount Kings/Queens/Sultans from the Kingdom Region.

(3)

Where in a Kingdom Region there are fewer than five paramount Kings/Queens/Sultans, the House of Kings/Queens/Sultans /Sultans of the Kingdom Region shall elect such number of divisional Kings/Queens/Sultans as shall make up the required representation of Kings/Queens/Sultans for the Region.

Article 1 - 3.

The Federation National or Trans-Federation/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall -

(a)

Advise any person or authority charged with any responsibility under this Imperial Constitution or any other law for any matter relating to or affecting Monarchies;

(b)

Undertake the progressive study, interpretation and codification of Imperial Kingdom law with a view to evolving, in appropriate cases, a unified system of rules of Imperial law, and compiling the Imperial laws and lines of succession applicable to each throne, stool or skin;

(c)

Undertake an evaluation of Imperial customs and usages with a view to eliminating those customs and usages that are outmoded and socially harmful, while promoting best practices;

(d)

Perform such other functions, not being inconsistent with any function assigned to the Imperial Assembly/House of Kings/Queens/Sultans of a Kingdom Region, as

the Federation Royal Parliament or the Kingdom/National/ Regional Parliament may refer to it.

Article 1 - 4.

(1)

The Federation Kingdom/National or Trans-Kingdom/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall have appellate jurisdiction in any cause or matter affecting Monarchies which have been determined by the Federation/Kingdom/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans in a Kingdom Region, from which appellate jurisdiction there shall be an appeal to the Kingdoms Federation Cabinet, with the leave of the Federation Kingdom/National or Trans-National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans or the Kingdoms Central Government Imperial Court.

(2)

The appellate jurisdiction of the Federation Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall be exercised by a Judicial Committee of the Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans consisting of five persons appointed by that House from among its members.

(3)

A Judicial Committee of a Federation Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall be assisted by a lawyer of not less than ten years' standing appointed by the Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans on the recommendation of the Kingdoms Federation.

(4)

A member of a Judicial Committee of the Federation Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall be removed from office on the ground, of proven misbehavior or of infirmity of mind or body by the votes of not less than two thirds of all the members of the Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans.

(5)

A Judicial Committee of the Federation Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall have original jurisdiction in any cause or matter affecting Monarchies-

(a)

Which lies within the competence of two or more Federation Houses of Kings/Queens/Sultans; or

(b)

Which is not properly within the jurisdiction of a Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans; or

(c)

Which cannot otherwise be dealt with by a Federation/Kingdoms House of Kings/Queens/Sultans.

(6)

An appeal shall lie as of right in respect of any cause or matter dealt with by a Judicial Committee of the Federation Kingdoms/National or Trans-Kingdoms/National House of Kings/Queens/Sultans under clause (5) of this article to the Kingdoms Federation.

Article 1 - 5.

(1)

There shall be established in and for each region of Africa a Federation/Kingdoms House of Kings/Queens/Sultans.

(2)

A Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall consist of such members as the Kingdoms Federation may, by Kingdom Central Government law, determine.

(3)

A Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall -

(a)

Perform such functions as may be conferred upon it by or under an Act of Federation Central Government;

(b)

Advise any person or authority charged under this Kingdoms Federation Constitution or any other law of the Kingdoms Central Government with any responsibility for any matter relating to or affecting Monarchies in the Kingdoms/Region;

(c)

Hear and determine appeals from the Imperial Councils within the Kingdom/Region in respect of the nomination, election, selection, installation or deposition of a person as a King/Queen/Sultan;

(d)

Have original jurisdiction in all matters relating to an Imperial throne, stool or skin or the occupant of a paramount throne, stool or skin, including a Queen/Sultan to a paramount throne, stool or skin;

(e)

Undertake a study and make such general recommendations as are appropriate for the resolution or expeditious disposition of Monarchies disputes in the Kingdom/Region;

(f)

Undertake the compilation of the customary laws and lines of succession applicable to each stool or skin in the region.

(4)

The original and appellate jurisdiction of a Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans shall be exercised by a Judicial Committee of the Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans consisting of three Kings/Queens/Sultans appointed by the Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans from among its members.

(5)

A Judicial Committee of a Federation King/Queen/Sultan shall be assisted by a lawyer of not less than five years' standing appointed by the Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans in the recommendation of the Federation.

(6)

A member of a Judicial Committee of a Federation House of Kings/Queens/Sultans may be removed from office on the ground of proven misbehavior or infirmity of mind or body by the votes of not less than two-thirds of all the members of the Federation House of Kings/Queens.

Article 1 -6

(a) Citizens of the Kingdoms Federations may exercise popular participation in the administration of justice through the Federations institutions of public and customary tribunals and the jury and assessor systems.

(b) The judicial power of Federation shall be vested in the Imperial Throne Judiciary with the Council of Elders as the Imperial Throne Advisory Council; accordingly, neither the Empire Government Prime Minister, Kingdoms Parliament, Kingdoms Cabinets nor any organ or agency of the Kingdoms

Prime Minister or Kingdoms Parliament shall have or be given final judicial power.

- (c) The Thrones Chief Justice shall, subject to this Federation Constitution, be the Head of the Judiciary and shall be responsible for the administration and supervision of the Judiciary.
- (d) The Federations Judiciary shall have jurisdiction in all matters of Kingdoms Laws civil and criminal, including matters relating to this Constitution, and such other jurisdiction as the Imperial Matriarch Throne may, by law, confer on it.

Article 1 – 7

- (a) The Federation Judiciary shall consist of; The Federation Superior Courts of Judicature comprising
 - (i) The Federation Imperial Court of the Imperial Throne;
 - (ii) The Federation Court of Appeal; and
 - (iii) The Federation Royal Court and Federations Kingdoms Regional Tribunals.

Article 1 – 8

- (a) According to the Federation Constitution, the Federation Imperial Court shall consist of the Federation Chief Justice and not less than nine other Federations Justices of the Imperial Court.
- (b) The Federation Imperial Court of the Imperial Throne, which consists of the Federation Imperial Matriarch Throne and ten other Federation Justices, is the final court of appeal and has jurisdiction over matters relating to the enforcement or the interpretation of Federations Kingdoms law.

Article 1 – 9

- (a) The Federation Court of Appeal, which includes the Federation Imperial Matriarch Throne Court and not fewer than ten other judges, has jurisdiction to hear and to determine appeals from any judgment, decree, or Federation Kingdoms Court of Justice order.
