## The “Verses”

### **Intuitive vs. Psychic**

Although many people use the terms *psychic* and *intuitive* interchangeably, and although they are very close in fundamental nature, they are not the same thing. While all psychics are *intuitive*, not all intuitives are *psychic*. Intuition is an unconscious form of knowledge. It is immediate and often not open to rational/analytical thought processes. Intuition differs from an opinion since opinion is based on experience, while an intuition is held to be affected by previous experiences only unconsciously. Intuition also differs from instinct, which does not have the experience element at all. Intuition is trans-intellectual, while instinct is pre-intellectual. A person who has an intuitive opinion cannot immediately fully explain why he or she holds that view. However, a person may later rationalize an intuition by developing a chain of logic to demonstrate more structurally why the intuition is valid. Intuition is one source of common sense. It can also help in induction to gain empirical knowledge. Sources of intuition are feeling, experiences and knowledge. These things typically define the **Intuitive**.

A **Psychic**, on the other hand, is someone who is, in most cases, very sensitive to nonphysical forces lying outside the sphere of physical science or knowledge, and exhibit strong sensitivities to nonphysical or supernatural forces and influences.

### **Psychic vs. Psychic Medium**

As with the above difference between psychics and intuitives, all mediums are *psychic* but not all psychics are *mediums*. A **Psychic's** purpose is to provide validating information about the sitter's (the person receiving the reading) energy concerning their life issues and spiritual growth whereas a **Psychic Medium's** purpose is to help provide proof of an afterlife by perceiving validating information from the Other Side (those who have departed from physical living).

The goal of both the Psychic and the Psychic Medium is to create a healing energy that enlightens and helps the sitter on his/her personal journey and does not foster or create a dependency on the reader (the Psychic / Psychic Medium).

Some Psychics can also communicate with a sitter's spiritual guides. In general, the major difference between a Psychic and a Psychic Medium is the adept ability to communicate with those who have crossed over.

Based on information provided above – though you will easily find people and resources that disagree with these interpretations – one can now infer that all mediums are also psychic and intuitive.

## Sabrina – A Little Psychic Background



I have been out of the psychic closet now for a period of time, and what an experience it has been. I have developed an even deeper appreciation for the amount of work, time, and energy that *\*natural* psychics, especially mediums, take on and expend in order to assist their clients. It's both emotional and rewarding. I laugh and cry and rejoice with those I work for, and I consider it an honor to discern for each and every client.

Since going public with these skills, I have met many amazing people from around the world, both in person and by phone. I never expected to have international clients this early in my psychic career – I'm not sure I expected it ever to happen; yet here we are, blessed by God.

Prior to coming out of the psychic closet, I had (and still do) regularly employed psychic skills in healing sessions, I had been what I refer to as a "closet psychic" for most of my life, sharing my full abilities with only a limited few, primarily with very close friends and a few family members. The demonstrations of my skills were predominantly spontaneous events – unplanned, unstructured, and occurred when I least expected them to. During a short period in my mid-20s I started to just blurt out whatever to whomever as I received and understood it. I was not very savvy in these matters and it caused me, and others, some difficult times. Some people simply do not want to be read. And my delivery lacked tact. I was not yet polished, so to say. After a few unpleasant events caused by my primordial efforts, I once again crawled into the psychic closet.

During my time there, however, I learned how to hone these skills and the ethics of using them wisely and only when warranted or asked. The next few years proved to be a very educational period for me, and in my late twenties and early thirties I began widening the circle of those with whom I shared my now more refined skills. Many times through my life I had been urged to share my abilities more openly, and thus, in July 2006 I went public with my skills.

Throughout my life, some of my closer friends and I tracked my accuracies and within two years discovered my, albeit unscientific, accuracy rate to be approximately 85%. This accuracy rate is showing to be similar in my professional planned and structured readings and I expect them to continue this way.

The extent of my experiences, both psychic and mediumistic, is so enormous I could fill tomes with the stories. And the volume of experiences and stories continue to grow ...

**\*Important Note:** I am a natural psychic which means I did not receive training to open my psychic abilities. I have simply always been psychically open. Additionally, I do not employ outside tools – tarot, ouija, spirit board, oracle, crystal divination, card decks of any kind, etc - in psychic / psychic mediumship readings. I am

however a trained and certified Numerologist and a beginning level Astrologist, though do not use these tools in psychic / psychic mediumship readings. Psychic / Psychic Mediumship is very different from Numerology and Astrology, which are *scientific tools* for assessing a multitude of aspects of an individual's life and personality.

## Receiving a Reading

### The Basics – Applicable to All Readings

When receiving a reading it is very important to be aware of a few factors:

- **No psychic is 100% accurate**
  - An average psychic's accuracy is between 60% and 65%
  - A good psychic, between 66% and 76%
  - A very good psychic generally *maintains* between 77% and 80% accuracy
  - An exceptional psychic generally *maintains* between 80% and 85% accuracy
- **Psychics do make mistakes!** (And I'm no exception.)
- **An honest psychic will tell you what s/he receives**, *which may or may not be what (or from whom) you want to hear*
- **Come with an open mind** - a closed mind can block the flow and accuracy of a reading
- **Come drug- and alcohol-free** - these substances almost always block flow and accuracy
- **Give the reader little initial information** - during the reading answer questions only with a simple Yes or No. If you wish, you can expand on your answers *after* the reading portion of the session has been completed
- **If you have recently lost a loved one, it is best to wait at least 6 months before seeking a mediumship reading.** This is best for *your* mental and emotional welfare. Most honest Psychic Mediums will not see you if the loss is recent.
- ***Please respect the reader's time.*** Once you have been notified the reading time is over, politely thank the reader and take your leave.
  - Most readers have some type of soft alarm to indicate the reading is over; others will let you know verbally that time is up.

Remember: a psychic / psychic medium will give you the information s/he receives in his/her frame of reference. It is best, if the information you receive does not automatically make sense, for you to follow your own translation that comes from your own spirit / heart.

If you receive a reading that indicates a possible unpleasant future, consider it a learning opportunity, and use it as a guide rather than something predestined that you cannot change. You can always shift your course, rearrange your plans, alter your thinking, and change your mind.

Lastly, please **do not play "Test the Psychic"**. This is demeaning and very rude behavior and can end a session very quickly. A psychic cannot tell you what you ate for breakfast or what you wore yesterday. It defeats the purpose of a reading and wastes your time and the psychics. If you do intend on playing "Test the Psychic" expect a) a very inaccurate reading, b) being escorted out of the Gallery / office, c) being completely ignored, and d) that you will still be held legally liable for paying the *full* amount of your scheduled reading time.

## **Gallery-Like and Event Readings**

Where you sit has no bearing whatsoever on whether or not you will receive a reading during a Gallery demonstration. If you are meant to be read, you will be. There is also no guarantee you will receive a reading in a Gallery setting.

If you do receive a reading during a Gallery event, be open to receiving from psychic, Spiritual Guides, and loved ones who have crossed over. Expect nothing but be ready for anything.

Be open to the process. Bring pen and paper to take notes and when possible attend with someone else you know. Attending a Gallery with someone you know and having pen and paper ready will allow you and the person you attend the reading event with to get the most out of it should either of you receive a reading. While the one is receiving a reading, the other can take notes!

## **Private Readings**

*If you have a specific area of concern or are hoping to hear from someone specific on the Other Side, be up front with the reader what you are looking for. By the same, remain open to receiving information / contacts you didn't expect ... or perhaps did not even want. Psychics cannot control what information or what In-Spirit relative / friend comes through.*

*When seeking specific information, it is very important to give the reader a clear understanding of the issue for which you are seeking help. Not clearly stating your intentions is a level of playing "Test the Psychic". In such cases, you might need to help the psychic help you. Value the time you have during the reading and make the most of it.*

Be open to the process. Bring pen and paper to take notes. Record the session for later review.

Probably one of the most important things - if you don't want to hear (or possibly cannot handle) an honest answer as received and discerned by the reader then it is better to not ask the question.

## How to Get A Good Reading

Excerpted and paraphrased from article *How to Get a Good Reading* by Maria Shaw

### Things to Ask

1. Ask the reader about fees, and also about the specific type of reading you can expect. Also inquire how long the session will last, what you need to bring to the appointment, and if you are allowed to ask questions after the reading is finished.
2. Ask if you can bring a tape recorder or take notes. Some readers do not allow recordings of the sessions. Others welcome it.
3. Ask prospective readers to tell you a little bit about their background and experience. For example, how long they have been reading and what they specialize in. Some readers specialize in specific areas such as relationships or health.

### Your Appointment

1. **Be on time. Come with an open mind.** Many times seeing a reader is just like going into a counseling session. There really isn't anything spooky about it. But first-timers can be a little intimidated. So relax. Take a few deep breaths.
2. **Sit directly in front of the reader** unless you are directed to do otherwise. Don't cross your arms or legs - this can block energy between you and the psychic.
3. **Refrain from talking and asking a lot of questions up front.** Let the reader do the talking. See what s/he has to say first. If you are telling the reader everything about yourself, then you are not receiving a reading. The psychic can be influenced by what you are saying, and this may influence the outcome of your reading.
4. **A good reader will not ask you,** "How old are you? Are you married? Are you in school? What hobbies you do have?" Sometimes, a reader will however ask you for confirmation to make sure s/he is on the right track. For example: "I see you are working part time right now, on the weekends at a restaurant. Is this correct?" In such cases, a reply is warranted. It helps the reader to know s/he is making an accurate connection, and then s/he can move on to further predictions.
5. **It is not polite to shake your head "no" all the time,** even if the reader is telling you things that you do not agree with or understand at the time. Be open to the information, write it down, and see what manifests in the future. After all, you are here to see what lies ahead!
6. **Have a list of questions.** After the reader is finished, s/he may ask you if you have any. Some s/he may have already answered, but if not here's your

chance. You can ask now for more details and clarification about something that was already discussed in the reading, too.

### **Other Information**

If you find a good medium, hang on to him/her. There are a lot of ordinary readers available, but very few are great! Remember that no one can be 100% accurate, but you should expect a reader to be at least 77% - 80% accurate in his or her predictions. Finding a reader that "connects" with you is important, too. Your best friend may see a psychic that he raves about. That psychic may be 90% accurate on your friend's predictions but only so-so for you. Shopping for a reader is like shopping for a good pair of shoes. Some fit just right, others don't!

There are readers with whom you'll make a personal connection right away. Others you'll walk away from, wondering, "What did he really tell me?" Have a little patience and an open mind - and don't give up. Besides referrals, you can find psychics at fairs, expos, and on the Internet.

Don't waste a lot of money trying out different people. You can get mini-readings at fairs for as little as \$10. A full reading, depending on the area in which you live, can range from \$50 to \$90. In larger cities, and with psychics that have appeared on television and radio, fees may be higher, ranging from \$100 on up to \$600.

### **What You Can Expect from A Reading**

1. An average full reading can range anywhere from 20 minutes to 1.5 hours, depending on the type of reading you are receiving. Some readers can give you quite a bit of information in as little as twenty minutes. If you have a lot of issues, you may need more time, so an hour is not unreasonable.
2. Your reader should give you details and *possible* timeframes for events to unfold.
3. Besides personality traits and reading the "past," a reader should be able to give you predictions for your future. Some readings are good for three to six months, others for up to a year. Ask your reader how long your reading is good for.
4. The reader should allow you to ask a few questions.

On another note, I want you to know that **nothing is written in stone. If you do not like something in your reading, you can change it.** Readings can tell us of times ripe with opportunity, and warn us when to be cautious. If I were to read your cards and tell you that you could get a speeding ticket tomorrow on a certain road, you could change the outcome of that. You either won't drive that road tomorrow or you'll abide by speed limits. So remember, you *can* change what is said. You *do* have control over your own destiny. If I saw that you would have money problems in the next few months, you may decide to take that information and change the outcome of the prediction by not splurging on "extras" or by securing a part-time job.

I do not believe psychics should tell people anything bad – such as that they are going to get a terminal illness – unless they have a chance to change it. This is one reason first-timers are often leery to have a reading – they don't want to hear anything negative. I have heard horror stories of psychics telling people they have a dark cloud over their head or a hex on them. Then the so-called advisor wanted the client to give them \$400 to burn candles to take the spell away. These are the type of readers that give the truly gifted ones a bad reputation. These bad apples have caused the psychic industry to be looked down upon and viewed with skepticism.

Scam artists prey on people's emotions and make empty promises. They do exist, and there are plenty of them out there. If you encounter such a person, refuse to believe and immediately leave. Do not give them any of your money. I also suggest turning them in to the local law enforcement agency. This is another reason why referrals are the way to go when searching for a reader.

A good, honest reader will give you choices. S/He will give you encouragement and hope and will be positive and upbeat. You should feel happy and more in control of your destiny after a reading. If there is a challenging period approaching, a good reader will often be able to tell you how to work around it, deal with it, or completely avoid it. *You are the only person who controls your fate.* A reading is like a flashlight: it can light your path, but ultimately, you must be the one who chooses to walk it ... or not.

## Planning Your Gallery-Like or Private Mini-Reading Event

### Inviting Your Guests – By Phone

MGR: required minimum: 8 attendees; maximum: 20 attendees

PMR: required minimum: 5 participants; maximum: 10 participants

1. Make a list of people you would like to invite. (see "Invite List" on page 13).  
All participants must be 18 years of age or older, or be legally emancipated, or attended by parent or guardian.
2. Schedule a few short times when you will be free from interruptions to make calls. Personally, when I do invites for anything, I set aside time in 20-minute blocks. This keeps me from getting caught up in conversations that have no relevance to my reason for calling, and also keeps me from catching "phone call burn out". [I would not make a good secretary. lol]
  - a. Do, however, what works for you. If you can stand being on the phone and making call after call for an hour, by all means, go ahead. = )
3. The most important thing is to keep it simple and the conversation light.
4. Important points to mention -
  - Cost to participate: **GLGR – all fees are the responsibility of the host(ess)**
    - **GLGR:** \$160.00 first 8, plus \$14.00 per each additional
      - individual reading not guaranteed
    - **PMR** – \$20.00 per attendee
      - private individual readings guaranteed
  - They are **encouraged to bring pen and paper** to take notes
  - Let them know I am an experienced professional psychic / medium
  - For those who have kids, **a friendly reminder that this is adults only**
  - Some people might want to know how we met / how you know me / found me – tell them
  - Mention that this is **not a form of entertainment**, but rather an educational, and possibly a life-changing, experience

*Invite more people than you expect to attend. Sometimes people have urgent matters or emergencies that arise at last minute: babysitters fall through, cars act up, etc. You just never know what might happen. Others will decide at last minute they do not want to participate. Expect the unexpected. Over-invite. If everyone shows up, *and* we have more than the maximum participants, we'll work with it.*

### **Inviting Your Guests – By eMail / eFlyer**

*Required minimum: 7 attendees; Maximum: 20 attendees*

A very creative Gallery-Like Group Reading host created a fun, friendly, an educational e-Flyer that she then sent out through email in an attachment. I thought this was an excellent idea, which also added an element of professionalism to my services – I am professional and present all my work as such.

Feel free to create an eFlyer to send to your guest list through email. Before sending it out, I must have a chance to review it for approval. This is required so I can be certain the information contained in the eFlyer is accurate.

**Want to do an eFlyer invite but do not have time or desire to create your own?** For a nominal fee of \$15.00, I'll create and design an e-Flyer for you which you can then send to your potential guests. eFlyer requests must be received at least three weeks prior to your scheduled Gallery-Like Group or Private Mini-Reading event.

If someone very much wants to come but absolutely cannot make it to your GLGR / PMR, here are two options:

1. If you have enough people to warrant two GLGR / PMR, consider having two. People who attend the first are welcome to attend the second, though please give priority space to those who did not receive a reading / message during the first gathering.
2. If option 1 is not something you wish to do, feel free to give out my email ([sabrina@lsdevaney.com](mailto:sabrina@lsdevaney.com)) and suggest they schedule a GLGR / PMR of their own or have them contact me for a private reading.

### **Setting Up –**

- Please have all your guests there prior to my arrival. This will help prevent me from overhearing anything in general conversation before the reading time begins.
- Be sure you have adequate space for everyone to sit and relax comfortably in one localized space. Seating should allow everyone to be able to face me throughout the entire reading time.
- Comfortable lighting is also ideal, enough so that those who are taking notes can see well enough to do so, yet soft enough it doesn't bother anyone's eyes. [Excessive lighting and lots of bright lights can be very distracting to me (the reader).]
- If you wish, you may play very soft, low volume relaxation music. (Sometimes I find it distracting during the reading portion, other times I find the distraction of the background music very helpful. If I'm having difficulty either way, I'll be sure to let you know.)
- **Please turn off phones, cell phones, radios, computers, etc.**
- The area in which you chose for the GLGR / PMR should be smoke-free – at least during the Reading Time, and cleared of any previous old smoke for at least 24-hours prior to the gathering



### **Natural Readings (without Tools)**

All readings are natural readings, which means I do not employ tarot, Ouija, spirit boards, oracle, crystal gazing, card decks of any kind, etc., and do not request or require any information about you or your guests beforehand. I have no idea what type of information will come for whom, meaning: until we begin the actual reading time, I will not know if the sitter (person being read) will receive information from a guide / spirit or from a crossed over loved one or from general psychic skill.

### **The Reading Time**

- Introduction: once I arrive I'll introduce myself to your guests, giving general information about my experiences and skills. I'll allow a couple minutes for brief questions about my skills and experiences.
- The Readings / Messages will begin.
- Open for questions and answers.
- Closing: I'll pass out my business cards and a very short survey, and also request that attendees please inform me of any insights which come to pass following their experience with me. Gift certificates will be available for immediate purchase.

## Types of Readings & Fees

\*also available by phone or teleconference, restrictions may apply

**Psychic Readings** – \$65.00 / hour (unless otherwise noted)  
\$45.00 / half-hour (unless otherwise noted)

General Reading \* – general over-all reading with no specific focus; allows most important information that is best at the time for the sitter to present

### Specific Area(s) of Interest / Specific Questions \*

Topics for Specific Questions / Areas of Interest

- Relationships – children, spouse/significant other, family, friends, etc
  - Please note that questions of a prying nature and issues of infidelity will not be honored. Such information will be given if, and only if, it comes up within the reading of its own accord and giving such information is helpful to the sitter. Relationships readings are about YOUR ROLE in the relationship, not about the other person(s).
- Career/Work
- Finances
- Goals
- Talents
- Childhood
- Health (via Aura Reading)
  - May include physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual aspects
  - *If you have health concerns, please seek the assistance of a licensed healthcare professional*
- Spiritual
- Home
- Lost Items
- Other – please inquire before scheduling

### Specialized Readings, single-topic only

- Missing Persons / Crimes \*
  - Readings restricted, will work with law enforcement
  - Missing Persons / Crime are *fee-free readings*, though donations warmly accepted and appreciated

The following readings are \$90.00 / session, and are available only in person

- Age / Past Life, reading *and* guided meditation
  - Age – current lifetime
  - Past Life – previous lives
- Meet Your Helping Spirits, reading *and* guided meditation

**Mediumship** - for those desiring communications from crossed-over loved ones; may also include general psychic elements

Individual \* - \$90.00 / session

Family Rates \* – rates vary per family size, but will not exceed \$500.00; travel and accommodation fees may apply, please inquire; limit of 20 per family group; may also include general psychic elements

Although mediumship readings are available via phone and teleconference, the first mediumship reading is generally best when done face-to-face.

## **Events – Small and Large**

Gallery-Like Group Reading – \$160.00 for first 8, plus \$14.00 per each additional attendee; all fees are the responsibility of the host

Individual readings not guaranteed; travel and accommodation fees may apply; please inquire; includes aspects of both **psychic and mediumship**  
Minimum of 8 participants required, 1.5 – 2.5 hours

Private Mini-Readings – \$20.00 per attendee

Individual readings guaranteed; 15- to 20-minutes per each reading, varies per person; may include mediumship elements, but will not be prepared or strived for; travel and accommodation fees may apply.  
Minimum of 5 participants required.

Gallery-Like Group & Private Mini-Reading Combo – rates vary per group size - please inquire. Tailored to your groups needs.

Gallery-like portion includes mediumship

Individual readings guaranteed *for those who wish a private mini-reading*

- may include mediumship elements, but will not be prepared or strived for;

Travel and accommodation fees may apply

Minimum of 5 participants required

Event Gallery Reading - rates vary per event size, please inquire

Individual readings not guaranteed; travel and accommodation fees may apply; please inquire; includes aspects of both **psychic and mediumship**
